**Daylight Saving Time:** Please remember to advance your clocks by one hour on March 9, 2025. Please check batteries in fire alarms at your houses to make sure they are in working condition.

Tornado Siren Testing: To participate in the 2025 statewide tornado drill, the City of Cleveland will initiate the outdoor warning siren test on Wednesday, March 5 at 11 a.m. This is an opportunity for Missourians to practice their sheltering plans and ensure readiness in case of a severe weather emergency while at home, work or school. In case of severe weather on the day of the drill, it will be moved to Thursday, March 6, 2025, at 11 a.m. Each year, the National Weather Service chooses the date of Missouri's statewide tornado drill. **Extra Trash Pickup:** If you have extra trash/recycling WM can be contacted for extra cart or put payment stickers on extra bags and leave them next to the trash cart, the payment stickers are sold at Louisburg Price Chopper.

**Large/Bulk Item Pickup Requires Pre-Scheduling**: ). Residents are allowed to place one bulk item on the first pickup of the month next to their trash. <u>Please Call ahead</u> or use your online account with Waste Management (WM)M to inform if you are putting out a bulk item for pick up (800) 964-8988. **Appliances:** (with or without Freon) would be an additional cost and can be scheduled anytime by the resident calling the Waste Management (WM) customer service team (913-837-4637).

**Voter Registration: March 12, 2025,** is the last date to register as a voter for the General Municipal Elections to be held on April 8, 2025. Absentee ballots may be obtained from County Clerk's office; for info call 816-380-8102.

**Building Permits/Fence/Solar Panel Permits:** Building permits are required for any building or accessory building larger than 10 x12 feet. Only two accessory buildings are allowed on one residential lot. Permits are required for installing fences/solar panels. Permits required if replacement roofs include replacement of the decking.
